- Shampoo, body wash and lotion, deodorant, toothbrush and paste, no rinse body wash, hairbrushes/combs,

- Laundry detergent (pods or sheets are preferred), dryer sheets, paper towels, toilet paper, dish soap, dish sponges, disinfectant wipes, trash bags, tissues
- Gift cards to grocery stores (Will be used to purchase food items that are not available from local food pantries)
- Aldi, Harris Teeter, Weiss, Target, Meal delivery services such as Home Fresh, Hello Chef and Blue Apron
- Gift cards to pharmacy's (to purchase OTC medications not covered by insurance or other medical supplies) such as Walgreens, CVS, Hill's Drug Store, Rite Aide
