



## COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY

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### ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS REGARDING CITIZEN REPRESENTATIVES ON THE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

**WHEREAS**, on September 24, 2024, the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland (the "County Council") adopted an Administrative Resolution (the "September 24<sup>th</sup> Administrative Resolution") for the purpose of establishing a Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (the "Committee"); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2(f) of the September 24<sup>th</sup> Administrative Resolution provides that the County Council shall appoint seven (7) citizen representatives to the Committee, subject to certain residency requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Council is desirous of amending certain provisions regarding the citizen representatives on the Committee, as more fully set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, that:

1. Section 2(f) of the September 24<sup>th</sup> Administrative Resolution be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

*2. (f) Seven (7) to eleven (11) citizen representatives appointed by the County Council, including at least: one (1) resident from each of the municipalities of Easton, Oxford, Queen Anne, St. Michaels, and Trappe; one (1) resident from the unincorporated area of the County in the Chapel District or the Easton District; and one (1) resident from the unincorporated area of the County in the Trappe District, St. Michaels District, or Bay Hundred District. Four (4) citizen representatives shall serve for an initial term of two (2) years and thereafter serve for a term of three (3) years. All other citizen representatives shall serve for a term of three (3) years.*

2. All other sections of the September 24<sup>th</sup> Administrative Resolution not amended hereunder shall remain in full force and effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Administrative Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
