DECLARATION OF QUORUM PRESENT & RECONVENING THE MEETING

At 9:45 a.m. Denise Lovelady motioned to recess the regular Talbot County Board of Elections Board meeting and reconvene the Board of Canvassers. Walter W. Black seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously. There was a quorum of the Board of Canvassers, and at least one member of the Board of Canvassers who is a registered voter of the principal minority party was present. The meeting was held in Conference Room #1 at 215 Bay Street, Easton, MD.

Walter W. Black, as Chair of the Board of Canvassers, turned the meeting over to LBE Director Tammy Stafford.

Tammy Stafford announced that this would be the meeting when the Board of Canvassers normally would approve the minutes from all of the Board of Canvasser meetings for the 2024 Presidential General Election cycle. However, she requested additional time for the office staff to review the minutes and provide drafts to the Board of Canvassers. Barbara H. Perry motioned to postpone the Post-Certification meeting to 12/18/2024. Gagy Irving, III seconded the motion, which then passed unanimously.

Tammy Stafford reported that the office had received seven (7) ballots since the Board of Canvassers had certified the Election. Tammy Stafford recommended that these ballots be rejected as untimely as they were not received prior to certification. Barbara H. Perry motioned to reject the seven (7) ballots as untimely for the Election. Denise Lovelady seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Denise Lovelady motioned to recess the Board of Canvassers meeting until 12/18/2024 after the regularly scheduled TCLBE Board meeting. Barbara H. Perry seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The meeting was recessed at 9:52 a.m.
