**A BILL TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE 9-1-1 CENTER AT THE TALBOT COUNTY OPERATIONS CENTER**

WHEREAS, Bill 1262 authorized the planning, design, construction, renovation, furnishing and equipping of an addition to the Operations Center for the 9-1-1 Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Expansion of the 9-1-1 Center at the Talbot County Operations Center is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the planning, design, construction, renovation, furnishing and equipping of an addition to the Operations Center for the 9-1-1 Center. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably necessary for, design, engineering, construction and completion of the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$3,595,000 for this project. This represents an increase of \$2,595,000 over prior authorization. Acceptance of Federal and State Grants for this capital project is authorized. The project will be funded by \$1,495,000 in funds from the Capital Projects Fund, \$2,000,000 in State and Federal Grants and \$100,000 of Development Impact fees. The increase is funded by additional State and Federal grants of approximately \$2,000,000 and additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of approximately \$595,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.

**A BILL TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAPPING AND EVALUATION OF COUNTY CULVERTS**

WHEREAS, Bill 1267 authorized mapping and evaluation of County culverts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The mapping and evaluation of County culverts is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to the mapping of all County culverts, the above and below water inspection of, and other repairs and maintenance to, selected County culverts. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges reasonably necessary for the completion of the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$100,000 in funding from the Capital Projects Fund for culvert mapping and inspections. This represents an increase of \$50,000 over prior authorization. The increase is funded by additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of \$50,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.



**A BILL TO AUTHORIZE A CAPITAL PROJECT TO UPGRADE THE REGION V (TILGHMAN) WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT WITH ENHANCED NUTRIENT REMOVAL (ENR) TECHNOLOGY**

BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: Expenditure of up to \$3,500,000 to upgrade the Region V (Tilghman) Wastewater Treatment Plant with Enhanced Nutrient Removal (“ENR”) technology which will improve the water quality of the effluent discharge is hereby authorized as a capital project.

SECTION 2: Borrowing to finance this capital project and the acceptance of Federal and State Grants for this project is hereby authorized. The project will be funded by \$2,100,000 in long term borrowing and \$1,400,000 in State and Federal Grants. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated transactional costs and for incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably required for, financing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. All costs incurred for this capital project shall be repaid from revenues generated by operation of the Region V (Tilghman) Wastewater Treatment Plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: Expenditure of up to \$4,916,000 for the planning, design, and construction of improvements to the Bio-Solids Septage and Grease Treatment Facility located at 9786 Klondike Road, Easton, Maryland shall be and is hereby authorized as a capital project.

SECTION 2: This capital project shall include refinancing of up to \$2,650,000 due on the original loan to purchase the facility, for a total capital expenditure of \$7,566,000. Borrowing to finance this capital project and acceptance of Federal and State Grants for this project is hereby authorized. This represents an increase of \$1,566,000 over prior authorization. The project will be funded by \$233,000 in State and Federal Grants, \$200,000 of Septage funds and \$7,133,000 in Long Term Borrowing. The increase is funded by additional State and Federal grants of approximately \$233,000, additional funds from the Septage Fund of approximately \$200,000 and increased long term borrowing of \$1,133,000. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated transactional costs and for incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably required for, refinancing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. All costs incurred for this capital project shall be repaid from revenues generated by operation of the Bio-Solids Septage and Grease Treatment Facility.



Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges reasonably necessary for design, engineering, construction and completion of the project.

**A BILL TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PASSIVE PARK ON OXFORD ROAD**

WHEREAS, Bill 1280 authorized the design and construction of a passive park to include park access and walking trails on Oxford Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Development of a Passive Park on Oxford Road is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the design, construction of a passive park to include park access and walking trails while preserving the natural characteristics of the property. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably necessary for, design, engineering, construction and completion of the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$645,000 for this project. This represents an increase of \$295,000 over prior authorization. Acceptance of Federal and State Grants for this capital project is authorized. This project will be funded by \$380,000 of Federal/State grants and \$265,000 of County funds from the Capital Projects Fund. The increase is funded by additional State and Federal grants of approximately \$280,000 and additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of approximately \$15,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.

**A BILL TO AUTHORIZE A CAPITAL PROJECT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A SCREW PRESS TO UPGRADE THE REGION II (ST. MICHAELS) WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT**

SECTION 1: Expenditure of up to \$600,000 for the installation of a screw press to upgrade the Region II (St. Michaels) Wastewater Treatment Plant to dewater sludge is hereby authorized as a capital project.

SECTION 2: Borrowing to finance this capital project is hereby authorized. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated transactional costs and for incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably required for, financing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. All costs incurred for this capital project shall be repaid from revenues generated by operation of the Region II (St. Michaels) Wastewater Treatment Plant.
